Prof. Dr. Serdar Ceylaner is a medical doctor - medical geneticist who focuses on rare and undiagnosed diseases for both diagnosis and scientific studies. He is the director, partner and founder of Intergen Genetics and Rare Diseases Diagnostic and Research Center and Lokman Hekim University, Department of Medical Genetics.
